Crisp apples, soft pears and delicate white flowers- what more could you want from a good pinot grigio?

An absolute hedonistic stunner from a very progressive Eco-conscious winery. Intense peach, poached pear and jasmine.

This is a very moreish juicy Sauvy! Sourced from high- grade parcels of fruit from some of the best growers in Marlborough. Passion fruit aromas and ripe tropical fruit on the nose, with super ripe citrus and gooseberry on the palate.

- 8 **LOUISE LATOUR VIN DE PAYS DE L'ARDECHE 2008 – FRANCE**
Rich, round and decadent Southern French Chardonnay.

- 9 **PRIMROSE HILL BACCHUS 2011 – ENGLAND**
Lovers of Sancerre will revel in this beautiful elegant English beauty, boasting mineral, acacia and granny smith apple. Grapes are sourced from some of the most pretty vineyards in Kent, this bottle really hasn't travelled far to reach you!

- 10 **FONDO ANTICO GRILLO PARLANTE IGT SICILIA 2010 - ITALY**
Scents of sea breeze, slate, quince and pineapple on the nose give way to crunchy mineral and zippy lemon the palate. True class from the volcanic slopes of Mount Etna.

- 11 **D'ARENBERG THE HERMIT CRAB VIOGNIER/MARSANNE 2010 – AUSTRALIA**
This wine really 'over-delivers!' Handcrafted, basket pressed and lovingly made by the effervescent Chester Osbourne, with flavours of honey, dried apricot and marzipan. Many of McLaren Vale's vineyards are on free-draining soils underlain with limestone, formed by the calcareous remains of the local marine fauna. One such creature was the Hermit Crab, a reclusive little crustacean that inhabits the cast-off shells of others.

- 12 **BASTIANICH VIGNE ORSONE FRIULANO 2009 – ITALY**
Joe Bastianich is a busy man. He owns a clutch of New York's most famous Italian restaurants in partnership with celebrated chef Mario Batali, is a judge on Masterchef USA, makes wine in four Italian regions, trains for Ironman triathlons and keep bees in his spare time. Just having lunch with him is exhausting. His wines are rated among the top in Italy, so don't miss out and try this amazing Friulano!

Sourced from 50+ year old vines giving an herbaceous, citrus nose with a hint of apple. On the palate almost a tropical fruit flavour with a zingy minerality and freshness.

- 14 **CHABLIS BERNARD LEGLAND 2010 – FRANCE**
A top quality domaine-bottled Chablis that remains clean, ultra-pure, with bright steely acidity and not so much as a hint of oak. Predominantly flinty with aromas of butter cream, honey, green apples, white flowers and a touch of mint.

- 15 **STONIER RESERVE CHARDONNAY 2008 – AUSTRALIA ^{R&I}**
"Lemon, tropical fruit, peach, toasty oak, butter and honey on the nose. Assertive, concentrated and straight-forward. Elegant, delicious and pure class." Decanter Wine Magazine. Stonier is recognised as a world class producer of exceptional Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

Glacé cherry and watermelon, and made for those who don't like it too dry.

- 19 **ALTO BAJO MERLOT 2011 – CHILE**
Lovely and smooth, with juicy plum, blackberry and damson fruit served up with lashings of mocha coffee and chocolate.

- 20 **THE SPEE'WAH DEEP RIVER SHIRAZ 2011 – AUSTRALIA**
Grown on limestone soils in north western Victoria, this Shiraz has a savoury black pepper flavour with a hint of spice and lifted fresh fruit on the finish.

- 21 **LAGRIMAS DE GARNACHA 2010 – SPAIN**
Forget Rioja! This is a small production premium Spanish Navarra (next door to Rioja) red with minimal oak used in its production. Super super ripe with vivacious aromas of rhubarb and raspberry... truly wonderful stuff.

- 22 **WANDERING BEAR MERLOT 2010 – USA**
This little Bear is a real softy. Lashings of plummy richness and a vanilla pod coat.

Since 1903 Castellani has been exporting its estate wines from Tuscany. Exuding bright red cherry fruits, dark chocolate and a wonderful herbal quality.

- 24 **RIVA LEONE BARBERA 2009 – ITALY ^{R&I}**
Dark berry fruits with a core of fine tannins and the typical Barbera acidity that makes these wines so food friendly. You can't go wrong with this one!

Blackberry jam with a dash of plum on the nose. Juicy tannins and hints of vanilla with a long earthy finish... perfect with a burger.

Light deliciously fruity and good fun, from the slopes of Switzerland.

- 27 **ARGENTO MALBEC 2011 – ARGENTINA**
Steak anyone? Big, chunky, rich and dark with aromas of blackberry, plum and dark chocolate. Grapes are selected from some of the best high altitude Mendoza vineyards.

- 28 **DON DUELO GRAN RESERVA TINTO DO CARINENA 2004 – SPAIN**
This wine is made from a blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha, which are also used to make Rioja. It boasts a rich and ripe character with spiced raspberry aromas and velvety vanilla flavours.

- 29 **DELICATO FAMILY VINEYARDS OLD VINE ZINFANDEL 2010 – USA**
Delicato is a family-owned winery that was founded in 1924 and is committed to California's winemaking and wine-growing heritage. Full bodied, supple in texture with lashings of chocolate and liquorice, big stuff!

- 30 **COTES DU RHONE ROUGE HAUT DE BRUN ALAIN JAUME 2009 – FRANCE**
From the slickest operators in the Rhone with cellars located in Orange, just up the road from Chateaufort du Pape. Giving a wide aromatic range showing fresh wild raspberries, blackcurrant, blackberries, liquorice and white pepper.

- 31 **FLEURIE LA CERISAIE MOMMESIN 2010 – FRANCE**
Fleurie is truly the feminine Beaujolais Cru. This example is super delicate, elegant and sumptuous.

- 32 **VALDIVIESO SINGLE VINEYARD CABERNET FRANC 2009 – CHILE**
A serious Cabernet Franc that is absolutely delicious and well worth a go. The grapes are sourced from a single vineyard in the Curico Valley, Chile. It really does scream class!

- 33 **ST HALLETT BAROSSA FAITH SHIRAZ 2010 – AUSTRALIA**
The 'bad boy' of the Barossa, with lashings of dark cherry, clove and black pepper. This really is serious, intense Aussie shiraz with bells on!

- 34 **D'ARENBERG STICKS&STONES TEMPRANILLO/GRENACHE/SHIRAZ 2008 – AUSTRALIA**
The Grenache and Tempranillo work beautifully together to produce red fruit flavours, tea leaves, spices, cracked pepper and dried herbs. Chester's (wine maker) philosophy is to make wines that have great fragrance texture and length.

- 35 **CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE ROUGE CHATEAU ST-JEAN 2009 – FRANCE**
With classic Southern Rhone terroir, including the famous Chateaufort pebble stones, and a modern winemaking philosophy, young winemaker Francois Mefre crafts up-to-date versions of one of France's iconic wines.

- 36 **STONIER RESERVE PINOT NOIR 2008 – AUSTRALIA ^{R&I}**
Not many wineries would have the confidence to pitch their wines against others from around the world – yet that's what Stonier do every year with their International Pinot Noir Tasting held in London. Forget overpriced and underwhelming Burgundy and try this hedonistic Pinot instead!

- 38 **LA BASTIDE DE DAUZAC MARGAUX 2006 – FRANCE**
It doesn't get any more classy and good value from Bordeaux than this, the second wine of Chateau Dauzac, Seme Grand Cru. Clean, intense and spicy with attractive blackberry and blackcurrant fruit flavours. Well structured with dense tannins agreeably finishing with lingering notes of cherry compote and strawberry coulis.

- 39 **THE STUMP JUMP STICKY CHARDONNAY D'ARENBERG 2008 – AUSTRALIA**
The nose is packed with rich flavours of marmalade, cumquat, ripe peach and orange butter. The palate is unctuous with the cumquat character coming through and layers of yellow peach, butterscotch and a hint of green apple.
